

Alternative Behavior Center II Student Orientation

Students are assigned to ABCII for a specific number of days for major behavioral infractions or persistent misconduct on their home campuses. Continued behavior problems in ABCII could result in additional days, extra assignments, suspension or even expulsion from the school district. All ABCII students are responsible for adhering to the Burnet CISD Student Code of Conduct as provided by their home campus in the Student Handbook and Discipline Management Plan.

Guidelines:

- * You will arrive and depart from school only on ABCII provided transportation or with the adults designated as legal guardian or parent on your enrollment form.
- * You will arrive on time, 7:55 a.m., and you will not bring anything with you to the ABCII campus. This includes no jewelry, watches, headgear, purses, backpacks, bags, coats or jackets, notebooks, pens or pencils. **Absolutely no** electronics including but not limited to cell phones, ipods, cameras, recorders.
- * You will remove any coat or jacket prior to entering the ABCII classroom and the teacher will store it in a designated area.
- * Your shirt will be tucked in from the time you enter the building until the time you exit the building unless you have earned the right to leave it out.
- * You will report directly to your assigned space where you will remain seated, awake, facing forward at all times unless instructed otherwise by staff.
- * You will raise your hand and await acknowledgement to request assistance.
- * You will address all adults respectfully. You will not backtalk, argue with or behave disrespectfully towards staff.
- * You will not communicate with any other student in any manner including gestures, talking or note writing, without permission to do so.
- * You are not allowed to have any gum, snack, candy or drinks.
- * You will have supervised restrooms breaks, at times determined by staff.
- * You will complete all assignments given while in ABCII with a minimum of 70 percent accuracy.
- * You will not participate in extra-curricular activities or school-sponsored events. You are not permitted on any other BCISD campus without the advance written authorization of that campus administrator. You can be filed on for criminal trespass for violation of this rule.
- * You will not drive a vehicle of any kind to the HLAC campus.
- * You will return to your home campus only after you have successfully completed the number of days assigned to you including making up all absences and days added if applicable.
